## KEEPING FAMILIES SAFE

### Outside of School-

- Most restrictive
- Families should adhere to CDC guidelines
- Face masks will be required with transportation

### At the School Entrance

- Highly restrictive
- All visitors and scholars will have temperatures checked and be asked general wellness questions
- No non essential visitors

### At the School

- Cautiously Restrictive- in common areas and outside of the classroom
- Implement social distancing
- May require masks
- Rigorously clean and disinfect
- Create isolation room for children and staff that are not feeling well

### In the Classroom

- Least restrictive
- While in the classroom, we will seek to be as normal as possible while remaining safe
- Masks will not be required but recommended
- Create consistent groups of children to limit exposure
- New cleaning protocols
- Adding hygiene routines
- Limiting the use of shared resources
